

#### Muslim Culture


- Around 650 AD armies expanded into and conquered North Africa, forcing people to convert to

   culture


- Europeans led by explore African coast as they seek trade routes to

- As Europeans colonize they come into competition with each other
  - of 1884 divides Africa into colonies amongst the European powers
  - Borders drawn with no regard to or input from
  - Some colonizing powers still fight over borders and resources (Boer War in South Africa)
- Only 2 countries escape colonization:
  - established in 1847 by freed slaves from the United States
  - Ethiopia: usedkeep from enforcing its claim
