How did the Portuguese gain support from the princes of southern India?

What 2 things did the Portuguese do in trying & failing to convert South Asia to Christianity?

What were the Indian soldiers fighting for the British and French called?

What country/empire managed to dominate trade, politics, & military power in India?

14-3: Rise of the Dutch and Spain seizes the Philippines (p. 458-459)

Who challenged and destroyed the Portuguese trade empire in Asia?

What/who caused the Dutch trading empire to collapse? What area did the Dutch maintain control over?

How were the Dutch and Portuguese trade empires similar and different?

Who laid claim to the Philippines for the Spanish? Why were they able to conquer and colonize the islands?

Explain the Philippines' role in Spain's global trade ring?

14-4: European Contact with Ming China and The Manchu Conquest (p. 461-464)

Why did the Ming require Westerns to trade gold & silver for Chinese trade goods?

What did the Ming require Western traders to do at the end of each trading season?

What did the Manchu call their rule of China? How did they gain support for their rule from Chinese scholars and officials?

How did trade contribute to the population boom of China in the 1700s?

14-4: Korea and Japan (p. 464-465)

How did the Koreans respond to Japanese and Manchu invasion?

What did the Japanese do when the 1st Western traders arrived?

Why did the Japanese finally kick out Western traders and isolate themselves?

Which country was the only one permitted to trade with Japan after it chose to isolate itself?
