## China

- China began losing its balance of trade
  - Britain began importing (smoked version of heroine)
  - Chinese economy and society began collapsing
  - Chinese banned opium but British
- Results in
  - Chinese warships attacked opium traders
  - British warships easily defeated Chinese
  - British took control of
  - Opened door for other countries to gain leverage

# China

- Weakness of the Qing leads to
  - Rebels take control of large areas for 14 years
  - Qing gov't retakes control with help of
  - In return for help, Qing have to
  - Rebellion lets Europeans claim more land
- China debated modernizing until losing to Japan in the Sino-Japanese War
  - Japan takes
  - Reformers launch modernize the country
  - After 100 days traditionalists end the reforms

## China

- When traditionalists couldn't deal with the foreigners,
  - Chinese simultaneously attacked across
    the country to
  - put down the rebellion and took more power away from China
  - Forced the Chinese to begin modernizing
- In 1911, the Qing Dynasty collapses and (western-style gov't) is established

## Southeast Asia

- Europeans began grabbing resource-rich areas

#### Latin America

- failed to come from independence movements
  - between social classes
  - People identified with local regions, leading to
- Example:
  - Local warlord Santa Anna built a dictatorship
  - Following defeat in war with US, liberals try making modern reforms, starting a civil war
  - Seeking stability, they turned to for guidance

#### Latin America

- During colonization, Europeans kept Latin
  America from economic independence
- After independence Europeans & the US sent to do the same
- Came to be known as <u>economic imperialism</u>
  - Manipulating another country's own profit
  - Led to governments
  - Kept poor people poor and prevented
